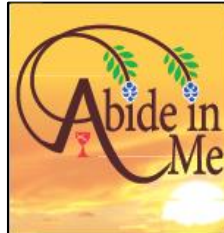

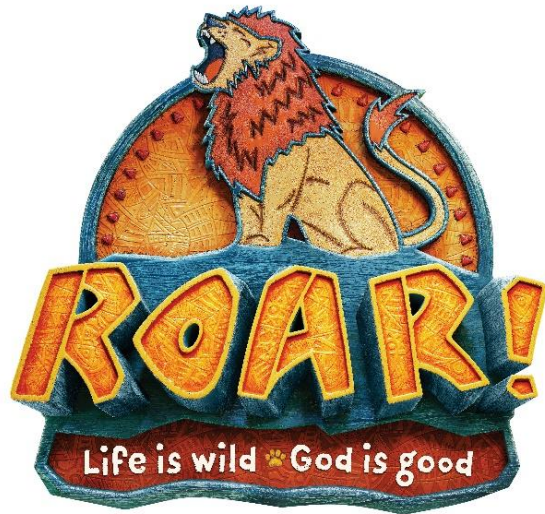
Go, Dog. Go!

We need help in the following areas:

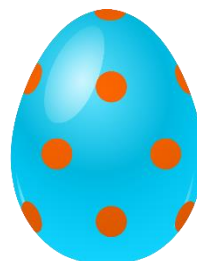
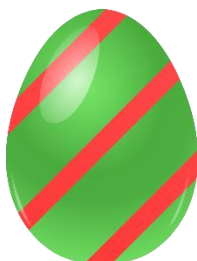
